Supplies Used:

- My Minds Eye (Laundry)
- Bazzill Flowers
- QuicKutz Moonlight "Counts Your"; Maddie Anne "Blessings"
- QuicKutz Butterfly REV-0088
- QuicKutz Cookie Cutter Border Leafy Vine CC-BDR-005
- EK Success lunch box Tin
- Other: Assorted buttons
- Other: Assorted Ribbon

Tools Used:

- Brayer
- Glue pen (ballpoint)
- Scrappy Glue
- Terrifically Tacky Tape

Designer Tips:

- If you have it, the double sided tape works great when applying the cardstock to the side of the lunchbox!
- This suggestion is from Jo and I used it! Make a copy of the top of the lunchbox (the side that has the handle and lid clasp) and use that as a template to cut your cardstock to fit. It will not be perfect but it will be better than "eyeballing it".
- Measure twice cut once.
- If you want to cover your candies in patterned paper try to find paper rather than cardstock. Cardstock (especially heavy cardstock) will "rebel" against the curve. Patterned paper will stay nicely wrapped much longer.
- If you use Hershey's nuggets the size to cut your paper covers is 1 inch by 3 inches.
- If you don't want to use candy for your "gratitude labels" cut out a variety of leaf shapes and have your loved ones (family, friends and visitors) write what they are grateful for and the date. It will become a tradition that you can reminisce over through the years.
