Supplies Used:

- Creative Imaginations Fawn box
- Yellow Bicycle Frightful paper line
- Yellow Bicycle Frightful googly eyes
- Yellow Bicycle Frightful 3D stickers
- Quickutz Dragonfly font
- Yellow Bicycle Frightful ribbons
- Bazzill Parakeet Pom-Pom ribbon

Tools Used:

- Mod Podge
- Brayer
- Sanding Block
- Scrappy Glue
- Glue pen (ballpoint)



Designer Tips:

- A little bit of Modge Podge goes a long way. If you use too much your paper could “bubble up” and not be nice and flat.
- Use Modge Podge on top of your patterned paper on your lid (top and sides) as a sealant. Hopefully, it will be well loved and well used.
- If you are using Modge Podge on your lid to adhere the Googly eyes, work in a small area. You don’t want it to dry before you have a chance to lay down your embellishment! Then you’ll have to apply more Modge Podge and you run the risk of the paper “bubbling” or tearing.
- Decide if you are going to use a knob or handle. Once you apply your Googly eyes or buttons it will be difficult to change your mind and add a knob. If you are going to cover the lid with buttons or eyes remember to leave enough room for the knob base.
