

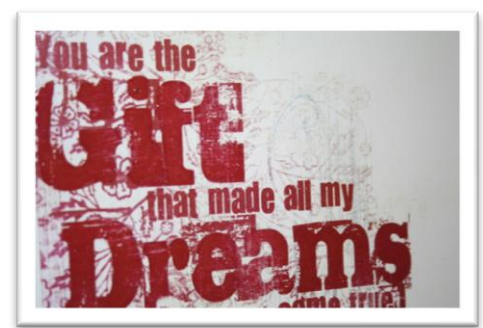
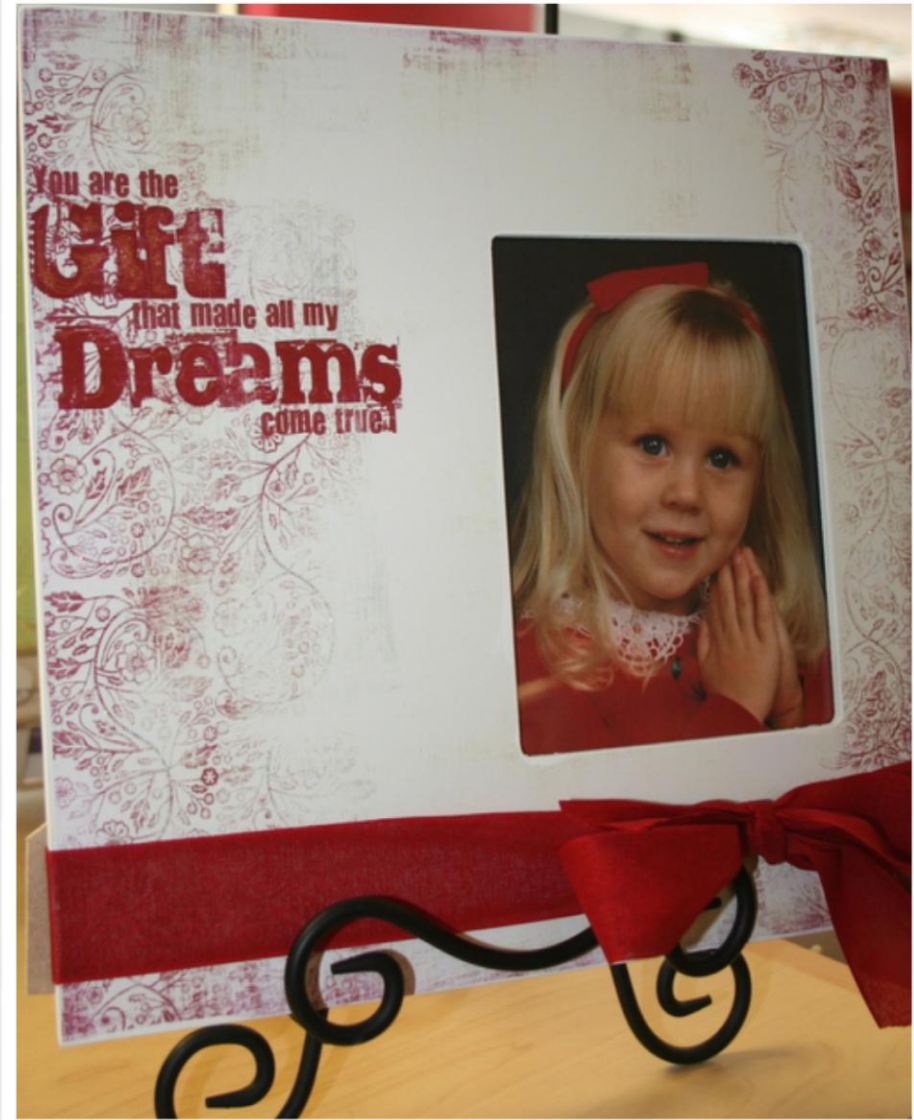
Frames

Tools Used:

- Mod Podge
- Scrappy Glue
- Brayer
- Sanding Block
- Distress Inks/ Paints

Designer Tips: There are 2 methods for cutting your paper. (1) You can lay the frame on the backside of your paper and trace the outside and inside of frame and them cut with scissors. (2) You can glue the paper to the frame and once glue is dry go back and use a Xacto knife and cut the inside and excess outside paper off. Make sure to get a good coat of Mod Podge on the frame before placing your paper on. Once you have the paper on smooth out all the air bubbles with a brayer. Once adhesive is dry sand off excess paper from edges with sanding block. The more you sand the edges the more distressed your paper will become.





Use Diamond Glaze to give a glossy finish over the lettering and add Stickles glitter glue for shimmer effect on flourish designs.
